Therapist II (FT - Oahu)

The clinically licensed Therapist provides professional treatment services to individuals and families seeking counseling. Position requires the provision of clinical treatment through individual, dyad, marital, family and group therapy in a variety of settings. The Therapist must have assessment and clinical skills, must have knowledge of family dynamics, understand trauma treatments and current best practice protocols. Through therapy, clients will address emotional and behavioral issues to promote healthy functioning in a variety of domains (family, school, work, etc). Services and treatment progress are closely monitored, and interventions are reduced as clients are able to function more effectively. The therapist must be credentialed to accept insurance reimbursement. The therapist must demonstrate an active commitment to Catholic Charities Mission and strive to incorporate the four Core Values in all aspects of daily work.

EDUCATIONAL & WORK REQUIREMENTS: Must have a Master’s degree in social work or related human services field, and a minimum five (5) years experience providing psychotherapy to individuals, families and groups. State licensure as a Clinical Social Worker, Marriage and Family Therapist, Mental Health Counselor, or related field capable of receiving insurance reimbursement required. Must be willing to work a non-traditional work schedule.

EMPLOYMENT CLEARANCE REQUIREMENTS: TB Clearance, CAN Clearance, FBI Clearance, HI State Criminal Check, Driver’s License, No Fault Insurance Card, Access to Insured Vehicle, Driver’s Abstract, Employment History, National Sex Offender Database.
