This position performs specialized activities as related to “children’s mental health” which involves students, teachers, administrators, other service delivery team members, parents and community agencies, including but not limited to counseling; student appraisal; consultation with school personnel, parents and community agencies; coordination with other programs and resources in and outside Catholic Charities; program evaluation and planning. The Youth Counselor must demonstrate an active commitment to Catholic Charities Mission and strive to incorporate the four Core Values in all aspects of daily work.

EDUCATION AND WORK REQUIREMENTS: Must have a Bachelors of Education or related field from an accredited college or university plus a minimum of four (4) years of counseling and guidance experience. In addition, must have experience in working with educational tests, measurements and statistics, research methods, community health, social and educational resources.

EMPLOYMENT CLEARANCE REQUIREMENTS: Education verification, TB Clearance, Hawaii State Criminal Check, Driver’s License, No-Fault Insurance Card, Access to an Insured Vehicle.
