Through therapy, clients will address emotional and behavioral issues to promote healthy functioning in a variety of domains (family, school, work, etc.). Services and treatment progress are closely monitored, and interventions are reduced as clients are able to function more effectively. The Therapist II must demonstrate an active commitment to Catholic Charities Mission and strive to incorporate the four Core Values in all aspects of daily work.
