The Family Support Worker (FSW) identifies and enhances the strengths of client families. The purpose is to support the optimal growth and development of children by helping parents reduce risk factors associated with child abuse and neglect. This position provides case management and coordination services for client families and is responsible for conducting and/or facilitating developmental screening on a pre-set schedule. This is accomplished in a home visiting format, utilizing child development/parenting education, community referrals, group support and by providing transportation services when needed. The Family Support Worker must also demonstrate an active commitment to Catholic Charities Hawaii Mission and strive to incorporate the four Core Values in all aspects of daily work.

EDUCATIONAL & WORK REQUIREMENTS: A high school diploma or GED plus a minimum of one (1) year experience in the area of child welfare and working with families.
