The Outreach Worker (HARP) must demonstrate an active commitment to Catholic Charities Mission and strives to incorporate the four Core Values in all aspects of daily work.

EDUCATIONAL & WORK REQUIREMENTS: Bachelor's degree in Human Services or related field. A high school diploma plus five (5) years of experience working in human services may be substituted for a Bachelor's degree. Experience working with veterans or knowledge of veterans services a plus.
