

Rent Relief & Housing Assistance Program



Has your income been impacted by COVID-19? Do you need rental assistance?

Catholic Charities Hawai'i has partnered with the State of Hawai'i to provide assistance to eligible renters & homeowners who have experienced a reduction in income due to the COVID-19 pandemic and are at risk of eviction or foreclosure. The program provides renters at risk of eviction with assistance in making monthly rent, as well as financial counseling.



Applications for assistance will be accepted for housing payments due between August 1 - December 15, 2020.



Eligible renters will receive monthly rent payments of up to \$2,000 per household on O'ahu, or \$1,500 per household in the Counties of Hawai'i, Maui or Kaua'i.



Monthly rent payments will be made directly to the landlord. Payments can be made in lump sums of up to three months at a time.



Final details are being worked out on a separate program to cover rents and mortgages beginning on March 1, 2020. More details coming soon.

You may be eligible if you:

- Are a full-time Hawai'i resident
- Are 18 years of age or older
- Have a valid and current lease agreement for primary residence in the State of Hawai'i
- Can demonstrate a loss of income directly resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Can demonstrate that your current household income does not exceed 100% Area Median Income, as defined by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for 2020.
